

Welcome

Dear guest,

You will find a bottle of wine and water in the fridge – as a first supply you will find coffee, tea, sugar and salt. In the market-hall at the Danube you will get everything you need for your daily living. Underneath there is a good supermarket for milk, rolls, drinks etc.

Across the street to your right behind the pharmacy you will find a 24h shop with bread and drinks. A little further at the first corner a grocery which opens Sunday until 14:00h.

Household goods you find on your left (leaving our house) at the first corner.

A few tips for your stay:

- Please always lock all outside doors with your key – not only slam.
- Do not alter the water-heater (boiler). The temperature can be controlled by separate switches at the wall and/or the heating-units.
- The windows can be darkened completely by opening the wooden boxes beside the windows – please pull carefully.
- Do not leave the windows open for longer period while the AC or heating is on.
- Sheets and towels are supposed to last one week. If you need more, please help yourself from the closet or bathroom.
- Piano and loud music: Please respect the normal rest-hours between 22:00 and 8:00 hrs.
- The garbage-bins are at the main entrance underneath the stairs – to be opened with your house-key.
- Your telephone will be checked and invoiced at your departure.

Parking: Hotel Korona left at Kalvin tér (right behind the main entrance) agreed daily rate for Kluge. HUF 500,- under the published rate = HUF 3900,- (as per Sept. 2004)

Public transport: tickets available under Kalvin tér at the right hand at the metro entrance and in news-paper shops. Be careful: each change of trains needs a new ticket. Ask for day or week tickets, they are good on all public transports.

Taxi: very good rates but simple cars: „Fötaxi“ with red/white diamonds on the doors, tel. 2222222. You find these taxis opposite the market or right at the beginning of Kalvin tér (not in front of the Korona Hotel). The so called Hotel taxis with coat of arms (fancy) are not recommended.

Airport: The Airport-Minibus will bring you to our house and will pick you up again. To be booked at the exit of airport. Tel. 2968555

Money: Never change money on the street. The many exchange bureaux in the city are ok but compare rates and refuse extra charges. The market-hall (entrance left corner) usually offers good rates.

Tourism: The Budapest Sun (english) and Pester Lloyd (german) appear on thursday.

reservation 1 day before is a must.
Closed Sunday.

- 2.) Mesterek: Pipa utca 2 leaving the house left around the corner. Inexpensive very good local food. Sunday closed.
- 3.) An exclusive and good place within 5 min. before Kalvin tér to the left: Kepiro etterem, Kepiro u. 3, tel. 2660430 (Sunday closed)
- 4.) Károlyi Étterem: V.Károlyi Mihály u.16, Tel. 3280240 (Enchanting summer-garden)

- 5.) Jazz Garden, Veres Pálne u. 44, across the road round the corner. Medium food but excellent daily Life-Jazz. tel. 2667364

From the many "typical" Hungarian places two are worth to be seen:

- 6.) Mathias-Cellar (Matyas-Pince), right before the Elisabeth bridge (very touristic).
- 7.) Karpatia, Ferenciek tere, also very scenic but decent food. Especially the beer-room (Sörözö) is worth a visit.

A few more specific hints for single apartments:

Apartment II + III (104 m²):

- The alarm-system should not be used without prior instruction and is meant for long-term tenants.
- The air-condition-units can be operated separately with each remote-control.

Apartment IV (54 m²):

- To light the gas-flame in the kitchen there is an extra switch on the left, for the oven you need a match.

Apartment V (44 m²):

- To light the gas-flame in the kitchen there is an extra switch on the left.
- In the summer you may place the small kitchen-table on the gallery together with the red folding-chairs (wardrobe).
